Core Curriculum:

English

We will focus on the book, 'The Pirate Cruncher' by J. Duddle.

Maths

We will continue to work on fractions, measuring capacity, statistics, length and weight.

Science

We will continue to explore the requirements of plants for life and growth. We will also explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.

We will investigate how animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that we get nutrition from what they eat.

We will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

We will be thinking about change; identifying changes that children may experience in their lives.

We will practise for Sports Day and play outdoor team games.

We will also be having a demonstration Judo Lesson.
