What we have been up to:

In Nursery we have been...

learning our Nursery rules.
Settling in and learning each other's names and making new friends.

Other areas of the Curriculum:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Getting to know each other and making friends.
- Learning to share and take turns.
- Talking about ourselves and what we like.
- Learning to follow the rules and boundaries in Nursery
(*Come and see our Nursery rules in class*)
- Talking about our feelings
- Sharing circle time together.

Core Curriculum:

English

- Listening to different stories about starting school and families
- Explaining the marks we make when drawing pictures of our families
- Exploring the mark making area with felt tips, crayons, chubby paints, chalks and pens.

Maths

- Counting songs and games
- Looking at the different shapes in our houses and homes
- Counting how many children here today.

Understanding the world

- Talking about our families
- Looking at pictures of our families and thinking about how we are the same and different
- Noticing changes during Autumn
- Tasting apples and making apple crumble
- Talking about Harvest and what happens at this time of year.

Other areas of the Curriculum: Special Activities

Settling into Nursery and making new friends!

Other areas of the Curriculum:

Expressive Arts. Being Imaginative

- Making collage houses and talking about who lives in our house
- Making self portraits in collage
- Painting at the easel
- Gluing and sticking independently
- Independent painting.

Communication & Language

- Practising listening to each other
- Listening carefully to different stories
- Listening to the adults and following instructions
- Talking about ourselves and our families
- Playing games where you need to follow instructions.

Physical Development

- Practising holding pencils, trying to use a tripod (three-finger) grip
- Explore the outside area including the climbing frame and balance bikes and trikes and cars/and balance equipment
- Continuing to be more independent when using the toilet and washing our hands.
