## What we have been up to:

### In Year 4 we have been.....

## Core Curriculum:

### English

### Maths

In maths the children will continue to develop their knowledge of using decimals. After this we will move onto measurement including money and time. The children will continue to develop their reasoning skills through a range of problem solving activities.

### Science

In science the children will finish their learning of 'Animals including Humans,' and will move onto learning about electricity. This will include completing various circuits and creating their own torch lights.

## Other areas of the Curriculum:

### Computing

In computing and ICT the children will learn to create their own games through programming.

### Music

The pupils will continue to develop their musical knowledge and performance through appreciating the work of ABBA and using instruments.

### PE

In PE, the children will move onto athletics and cricket throughout the Summer term. We will also be practicing for sports day.
