What we will be doing to settle into Nursery:

We will be learning each other's names including the staff. We will also be making new friends and developing relationships with new adults and our peers.

We will be learning to follow Nursery rules and routines.

Other areas of the Curriculum:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning to share and take turns, which will include sharing circle time together, talking about ourselves and what we like.

Parents and Carers are welcome to come and see our Nursery rules in class.

Core Curriculum:

Communication & Language

We will be practising listening to each other and learning how to listen to different stories. We will also be learning how to listen carefully to the adults and following instructions. When the children play games they will need to learn how to follow instructions which are being given to them by the teacher.

We will talk about ourselves and our families, talking to our peers and other adults in the setting. We will also talk about our feelings and what makes us happy and sad.

Maths

Number, shape and measures.

We will be counting in songs and games, looking at the different shapes in our houses and homes, and counting how many children that are here today.

Other areas of the Curriculum:

Expressive Arts. Being Imaginative

The children will be making collage houses and talking about who lives in their house. They will also be making self-portraits in collage as well.

The children will be painting at the easel, gluing and sticking independently, and doing independent painting.

Physical Development

The children will practise holding their pencils, trying to use a tripod (three-finger) grip. They will also explore the outside area including the climbing frame, balance bikes, trikes, cars and balance equipment. The children will participate in PE lessons which will take place in the main school hall.

We will be continuing to be more independent when using the toilet and washing our hands and taking shoes and socks on and off.

Understanding the world

We will be talking about our families, looking at pictures of our families and thinking about how we are the same and different. We will also be noticing the changes during Autumn. We will be tasting apples and making apple crumble and talking about Harvest and what happens at this time of year.
